Woodlawn ARC Submissions Report

We are in the final stages of completing the Submissions Report, a document that considers all perspectives and inputs received during the project's exhibition period. This report not only addresses the feedback from stakeholders and the community but also delves into the project's various topics of interest, incorporating additional study findings and modelling where necessary.

Proposed Amendment Report

In light of the feedback received and long-term operational needs, Veolia investigated a range of alternative options for the management of APCr. The proposed methods will treat the APCr material to General Solid Waste (GSW) classification, allowing disposal of the stabilised APCr into the Woodlawn Bioreactor landfill. This update will involve minor alterations to the development footprint, consideration of a contingency off-site disposal option for stabilised APCr and the removal of the previously proposed encapsulation cell.
