- Hold Supply Nation membership and other memberships, where deemed appropriate from time to time;
- Maintain commercial relationships with First Nations businesses;
- Provide opportunities for staff to procure goods and services from First Nations businesses;
- Train all relevant staff to contract First Nations businesses through Supply Nation or an equivalent organisation;
- Consult First Nations stakeholders and organisations to continuously improve guiding principles for engagement.

Veolia's contractors should:

- Respect and abide by Veolia's commitments as outlined in this policy;

- Communicate relevant business opportunities to capable First Nations businesses;
- Hold themselves accountable to proactive actions and targets for the engagement of First Nations businesses within their own supply chains.

All managers, employees and contractors are responsible for being aware of, and complying with this policy.
