THE FACILITY & TECHNOLOGY

EarthPower harnesses advanced anaerobic digestion technology to turn food waste into a natural biogas, which is captured and converted into renewable energy through onsite generators. The residual organic material is processed into a nutrient-rich soil improver, suitable for agriculture and landscaping applications.

Producing enough electricity to power its own operations while also feeding into the local grid, EarthPower is capable of powering over 4,000 homes, contributing to Australia's transition to sustainable energy.
